## 1963 Pontiac Lemans Top Sportsman/Pro Mod - Description Build Sheet Specifications

A mold was made off an original 1963 Lemans and the body was constructed out of carbon fiber. The body was delivered to JBRC in 2002. The construction of the chassis, body mounting, wiring, plumbing and paint was finished in November, 2002. The car has had a Pontiac engine since the initial build by Jerry Bickel Race Cars. In 2008, the front end and over-all wheel base was modified (stretched) to its present configuration by JBRC and a special front spoiler was incorporated into the front end (see pictures). JBRC incorporated their current "top of the line parts" in the build (see original build list enclosure). I also have the complete molds for building additional body parts.

In its present power train, the Pontiac engine utilizes a blown (14-71), alcohol injected engine making approximately 1800 horsepower. It has the latest in after market Pontiac parts and runs consistently in the 6.90 (ET) range at 195-197 (MPH) for the quarter and 4.40 (ET) at 159 (MPH) in the eighth mile. There are two sets of headers available (one Zoomie application and one under chassis type). There are two drive shafts available (3 and 4 speed Lenco units). The engine has approximately 20 passes on it since new, new Mark Williams differential and the 4 speed Lenco was freshened last year. The car is available with or without the power train. There are various spare parts that will be included. Enclosed are the individual items from the original build sheet:
